Vendor Licence Conditions 2018

Vendors must be licensed by the TDIA

To operate as a vendor you must comply with the provisions of the *Dairy Industry Act 1994*, (including any Codes of Practice developed under that Act), Chapter 3 of Food Standards Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code, and have a valid licence issued by the TDIA.

To be licensed you must:

- make arrangements for supply from a licensed milk processor,
- have a delivery vehicle (compartment) that complies with Chapter 3 of the Food Standards Code in relation to structural requirements, temperature control and sanitation
- notify the TDIA of any significant changes to your business, including ownership, vehicle, compartment, etc. and,
- pay the prescribed licence fee by the due date.
